Field Trip Information

Field Trips are organized by the [CCFMS Central Canadian Federation of Mineralogical Societies](http://www.ccfms.ca) to the Bowmanville Quarry twice a year - spring & fall - usually May & October.

- This location is not open to collecting by individuals or groups other than CCFMS scheduled trips.
- This trip is open to all members of CCFMS.
- No fee is charged, however, a [CCFMS affiliated club](#) membership card needs to be produced prior to entry.
- Pre-registration is required for this field trip - so that we know the number of participants.

Conditions

This is an actively working quarry.

- Collectors must be 16 years of age or older.
- Full safety equipment is required - hard hat, safety goggles/glasses, long pants, CSA approved "green patch" steel-toed safety work boots, and an approved safety vest.
- It is also expected that you will use gloves when collecting and wear a shirt/top that is safe & sturdy enough for collecting.



Liability and Sign-in/Sign-out + Arrival & Safety Talk + Departure

- 1) Please meet - no later than 8:30 am - at the Bowmanville Cement Plant (see map for co-ordinates).
- 2) Please check in with the Field Trip Leader upon arrival - and then ...
 - You will be required to show your current & paid up CCFMS affiliated club membership card.
 - You will sign a [Liability Waiver](#) along with the Sign-in/Sign-out sheet.
 - You will be given a car tag (one tag per vehicle).
 - If you plan on leaving prior to the end of the scheduled visit, inform the trip leader.
 - This is a very large quarry. We don't want to search for you if you have already gone for the day.
- 3) There will be a group Safety Talk at 8:45 am.
 - You are expected to follow all instructions regarding safety, collecting, and courtesy as outlined during the Safety Talk.
- 4) Entry to the quarry is at 9 am - in a vehicle convoy with the Field Trip Leader leading - to the designated collecting sites within the quarry.
- 5) Official Departure Time will be stated during the Safety Talk.
 - 5 minutes before Departure Time, you will hear honking. This is your signal to do your final packing up and to leave.
- 6) Regardless of your departure time, ensure that you inform the Field Trip Leader again.
 - That you sign the Sign-in/Sign-out sheet.
 - When exiting the quarry, ensure that you leave your car tag on the board provided.
