### Camping Checklist:

#### In The Car:

- Extra car key
- Note pad & pen
- Flashlight w/extra batteries
- Car tools
- All-Purpose tool
- Jumper cables
- Bungee cords
- Heavy blanket
- Wash Up wipes
- Medication for self (if required)

#### Food & Water while driving:

- (camping food is on a separate sheet)
- Traveller mug w/coffee and/or thermos
  - Water
  - Snacks / nibbles



#### Viewing / Communication:

(some of this is optional.)

- Cell Phone  
(preferably GPS capable)
- Cell Phone Charger
- iPad / iPod / tablet / laptop
- Charger for the above
- **Apps:**
- Offline Maps  
(if no GPS)
- Wi-Fi Finders
- Reading apps

#### Clothing

- Jeans and/or pants
- Shirts
- T-Shirts
- Undies
- Socks
- Swim suit (if on the itinerary)
- extra towels for swimming
- anything else you may need for swimming

#### Personal Hygiene:

(bare minimum)

- Tooth brush & paste
- Dental floss
- Deodorant
- Soap or shower gel
- Shampoo & Conditioner
- Towels
- Shoes/Slippers (of some sort) for camp showers
- Brush & comb

#### Camping Shelter/Sleeping Items:

- Tent
- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad
- Pillows
