- 1) Anthracite (3)
  - Late Jurassic ~160-145 Ma to the Early Cretaceous ~145-132 Ma
  - Canmore to Banff-Bow River area, Alberta.
- 2) Dinosaur Bone (1)
  - Late Cretaceous ~75 to 65 Ma
  - Alberta Badlands
- 3) Petrified Wood (2)
  - Paleocene ~ 65 to 60 Ma
  - Paskapoo Formation (Athabasca River), Alberta.
- 4) Petrified Wood (1)
  - Pliocene ~3.5 Ma
  - Beaufort Sea, NWT.
- 5) Glacial Scrapings (1)
  - Pleistocene ~2.5 Ma
  - northern Ontario
- 6) Petrified Animal Teeth (mounted)
  - Holocene ~12,000-7,500 years old
  - Florida
